

2018-19 Pilot Program Report & Learnings






For UE, 2018-19 has been a year of learning, contemplation, validation and growing from a seed to a seedling. We are extremely excited to share our journey with you as you have been integral to our evolution.

The action packed year started at a Govt aided school in the heart of the city when a child expressed the lack of educational guidance in his life, moving to NSRCEL IIM Bangalore where the building blocks of the intervention to plug the gap were set, moving to 4 Govt High schools in Bangalore where the intervention was then piloted.

As we collaborated and learnt we registered Anahata UNITED EFFORTS Foundation into a Section 8 not-for- profit organization with a mission to provide educational and career guidance to high schoolers from low income backgrounds.







PILOT MISSION

Understand the aspirations of Government high school children (8th, 9th and 10th grade) and their clarity or lack of it to achieve the same.



PILOT RESULTS








% of children interested in Animation Industry

Note: Social work was made mandatory for all, although some were very keen on this sector alone




It was interesting to see children open up and thinking about their career dreams. They were interested in the sessions and found them practical.



LEARNINGS

- 96% of parents want for their children to do well in studies and become professionals
- 98% of parents/family are unable to provide any support or guidance
- 3. Teachers are hard pressed to complete syllabus and show academic progress. They lack the resources and time to provide any educational or career guidance
- 4. Irrespective of aspirations, of the Government High School children who successfully complete SSLC:

80% choose Commerce in PU 15% choose Arts 5% choose Science



FEEDBACK

SCHOOL HM & TEACHERS:

- They appreciated that it was weekly program and not a one off workshop. They felt that the children needed more guidance and hence the weekly intervention and sustained model over 3 years would work better for the children.
- The HM advised that parents needed to get more involved and that the UE program should look at making the parents more supportive of their children's education.

BLOCK EDUCATION OFFICERS:

- Although infrastructure is a definite need, they appreciated that the UE program was focussed on children and improving their experience. They observed, given the distractions in the urban setting for a teen ager, this intervention would help the children remain focused on education and gain from the better opportunities there after.

STUDENTS:

- Students appreciated the content and methodology. In none of the schools children excused themselves during UE sessions. They found the information pertinent and useful for their future.
- They requested that there be more content delivery in Kannada, the local vernacular.



ROAD AHEAD

We AIM to impact 40,000 plus High schoolers in the coming 3 years

The program will run thro' classes 8, 9 & 10 and has 3 parts to it:

- DISCOVER different opportunities and match it to their interests
- REINFORCE: through industry visits, career fairs, role model talks
- SUPPORT through mentoring, admission and scholarships

3000 + children Our partners in this journey are Youth for Seva, NSRCEL IIM Bangalore (incubation), Whitefield Ready, India Literacy Project and Xpheno



OUTCOME - Information assymetry that exists amongst teenagers from lower income group is removed and with handholding they are able to pursue their dreams. India benefits from its Youth demographic dividend.
